The Fair:

Companies from Europe, Asia, America, the largest corporations specializing in road construction and special vehicles as well as all the domestic cement mills and steel plants were brought together at the only fair event of this kind in Europe, which is also Poland's second largest trade fair in terms of rented exhibition space.

The fair was held together with other important event - International Fair of Infrastructure TRAFFIC-EXPO. The 2009 edition was, despite the global crisis, a great success.

Description:

The International Fair of Road Construction Industry AUTOSTRADA - POLSKA attracted many companies representing 25 countries. An exhibition space of 38,000 square meters was used for presenting almost 2,000 pieces of equipment – beginning with devices of small size and finishing with the highest cranes. AUTOSTRADA-POLSKA featured products exhibited by the world's leading brands, companies, associations and other organizations – by all those expecting the motorway development programmer for Poland to pick up speed. The three-day-long AUTOSTRADA-POLSKA fair in Kielce was visited by almost 15,000 people.

The 5th International Fair of Infrastructure TRAFFIC-EXPO was held simultaneously during 12 -15 May in the Kielce Fair. The range of products and services exhibited at TRAFFIC-EXPO encompasses, among other things, elements of infrastructure related to road, rail, air and water transport systems; traffic management, safety systems, as well as maintenance of the existing transport network.
