The Infrastruktura fair is not very large, but well represented by the above mentioned companies and public organizations.

This fair is interesting for parties that are especially interested in information about the current investments concerning infrastructure (mainly road building).

Below you will find the most important information gathered on the fair, about the current state of Poland and her investments:

- Poland is the biggest construction site in Europe. At the end of the second quarter of 2012 662km of highways and 429 km of expressways in total are to be built. PLN 121 billion will be spent to build new roads and adjust the existing ones to expressways standards. The program adopted by the government covers the period 2008-2012. Poland will get PLN 35 billion from the European Union budget to improve infrastructure. The rest will be subsidized from the state's budget or other Polish and foreign sources. Here are the most important projects to be completed during the next few years:
 - A1 Highway: Gdansk-Torun-Lodz-Gliwice-Gorzyczki
 - A2 Highway: Swiecko-Poznan-Lodz-Warszawa_Siedlce-Kukurkyki
 - S1 Expressway: Cieszyn-Bielsko Biala-Pyrzowice
 - S2 Expressway: Warsaw southern ring road between Konotopa and Pulawska
 - S3 Expressway: Swinoujscie-Lubawka
 - S5 Expressway: Nowe Marzy-Wroclaw
 - S7 Expressway: Gdansk-Rabka

- S8 & S61 Expressway: Wrocław-Budzisko; Ostrow Mazowiecka-Budzisko
- S12 Expressways: Puławy-Piaski-Dorohusk
- S17 Expressway: Warszawa-Lublin-Piaski-Hrebenne
- S19 Expressway: Kuznica Białostocka-Barwinek
- S74 Expressway: Sulejów-Kielce-Opatów-Nisko

Important topics in the nearby future for the Ministry of infrastructure are:

- Decreasing the number of national road fatalities by 75% by 2012. By installing more speed camera's, creating more sidewalks, zebra crossings and others.
 - Attention for the environment: for example by equipping new road investments with water irrigation systems. *(Source: GDDKiA)*
- More and more cities in Poland are having or planning to have LED lightning in the street lighting systems. Main supplier of the LED diodes is Philips Polska. *(Source: Gazeta Samorządu I administracji Nr 20)*
- Current and upcoming investments of the Polish Railway in several voivodships

- Purchase of rails vehicles under the Regional Program 2007-2013
Investment: 20 mln Euro
 - Modernization of the rails under the Regional Program 2007-2013
Investment: 48 mln Euro
- Świętokrzyskie:
- Purchase of rails vehicles (rails busses) under the Regional Program 2010-2011
Investment: 19 mln Euro *(Source: Infrastruktura Transportu)*
- Investment: large 3 way fly-over crossing in Stryków near Łódź. Costs investment: 251,2 mln PLN. Contractor: Budimex.
The investment exists of: 10 viaducts roads connected to the A1 enA2 high way
