Subject	10th Fair for Sport Facilities, Fittings and Construction - SPORT-OBIEKT

The 8th Exhibition of Sport Facilities, Fittings and Construction SPORT-OBIEKT was held in Kielce, on 5 - 6 November 2008.

This fair event features new trends in the sports construction industry, a whole range of products used in sports buildings and access control systems. This year, products were exhibited by producers of equipment for sports halls and stadiums, as well as by companies specializing in sports and recreation equipment from Poland, Great Britain, Turkey and Austria. Visitors had an opportunity to become acquainted with well proven facilities which have already been installed in many stadiums, and with state-of-the-art technologies used for ensuring security within sports buildings. At the exhibition stands, there were also many interesting products which attracted attention even from the most demanding customers.

The Kielce SPORT-OBIEKT fair was visited by representatives of football clubs who specialize in providing security within stadiums; by presidents and vice-presidents of sports clubs, as well as by representatives of municipalities and local governments responsible for security and modernization of sports buildings. Each year, this fair attracts a growing number of representatives of local authorities, which is indicative of local governments increasingly making investments within sports infrastructure.

SPORT-OBIEKT was also visited by representatives of the Polish Football Association (PZPN), with its new President, Grzegorz Lato. PZPN was a co-organizer of the conference which also attracts an increasing attention from industry professionals, with significant media coverage also being provided, i.e. the International Conference "Stadium Security", with over 400

participants. This conference is part of a nation-wide campaign promoting security, aesthetic values and comfort in sports buildings. It is an excellent opportunity – not only for security professionals, but also for representatives of sports clubs from Poland and other countries, as well as for all organizations specializing in the improvement of security standards, construction and modernization of sports facilities – to exchange experience and share information. This year's special guests were representatives of the German police; they shared their experience gained during the World Football Championship, which our western neighbours organized in 2006.

The range of products and services exhibited at SPORT-OBIEKT was excellently complemented by exhibits prepared at the 9th Video Surveillance Conference and Exhibition ALARM. The exhibitions attracted a total of 2,000 industry professionals.

The organizers told us the fair will probably continue next year.
