Eunite Ukraine (EU): What is the current situation of the new runway construction in Donetsk International Airport?

Valentin Palamarchuk (VP): All construction works are held according to the schedule. And already next year we will have the new runway set into operation. This project is being fully financed at the expenses of Budget fund.

EU: What is the situation with your passenger terminal development?

VP: We plan to reconstruct the existing passenger terminal of the airport as well as to build a new one with a capacity of 1000 passengers per hour. Currently we are looking for a private investor to finance both these projects. The Donetsk Oblast Council has announced a tender for an investor, preliminary results of which would be known already on April 24, 2009.

EU: When do you plan to have them done?

VP: By 2011. Now it is important for us to find an investor. As soon as we have him, construction works could be launched.

EU: Do you plan any other additional development projects?

VP: Yes, we plan to upgrade an artificial surface of the airfield as well as to expand number of parking places to 54 permanent and 87 temporary (from current 30). Now we are working on the design development.

Also we plan to develop an air traffic control tower by 2011.
