Introduction:

Poznań is a city in west-central Poland with over 600,000 inhabitants. Located on the Warta River, it is one of the oldest cities in Poland, making it an important historical centre and a vibrant centre of trade, industry, and education. Poznań is Poland's fifth largest city and fourth biggest industrial centre. It is also the administrative capital of the Greater Poland Voivodeship.

Nowadays Poznań, as a one of the Euro 2012 hosting cities, is developing rapidly. Most of the infrastructure is being renovated and many projects are being build or planned to be build in the near future.

We have contacted Investor Relations Department in Poznań City Hall and we have spoken about the city development planes for the next years.

Projects:

Mr. Przyłębski has presented us the list of investments planned in the area of Poznan city for the year 2009. He mentioned that foreign investors, as well as equipment providers are welcomed to contact his office in order to find more detailed information. Below we are presenting the list of the investments.

- Integrated Communication Centre of the Poznań Główny railway station – building of new railway station, together with a commercial centre. Project is coordinated by PKP SA (Polish Railways). The bigger part of the project is due to be finished by the 2012,
- Poznań Forum – the biggest and the highest skyscraper in Poland. Multifunctional building with offices, apartments, hotel, and commercial zones,
- Korona Tower – apartments skyscraper,
- Radisson SAS Hotel,
- Promenade – commercial and service object,
- “Bulwary Poznańskie” – commercial town. Investor Ikea Center Group,
- A 11 Gallery – commercial centre,
- Centrum Łacina – commercial centre, hotel, offices, sports objects,



- Silver Tower – financial centre,
- Special economic zone – Poznań – Franowo. Object will be connected with high-tech investments,
- Termy Maltańskie – aqua park,
- Development of production facility Uniq Lisner,
- Extension of office building of Kompanii Piwowarskiej SAB Miller - brewery,
- Extension of Volkswagen production facility,
