PL.2012 is the coordinator and overseer of the preparational undertakings for Euro 2012 in Poland. The company has assembled A 46-member team of experts and qualified managers to be national coordinators in particular areas of oversight and operations. PL.2012 is working closely with the Ministry of Sport and Tourism, UEFA, the Polish FA and representatives of Ukraine. It is coordinating the work of the host city organizational bodies.

We had a phone interview with Mr. Stefan Dziewulski - mass sports events security specialist at PL.2012. The topic of discussion is the monitoring system of the National Stadium. Mr. Dziewulski said that Warsaw needs around nine hundred cameras in order to comply with the requirements of the new Act on Safety and Security of Mass Events. In his opinion, it is important to retain balance between the possibilities of realization of tasks stemming from the Act and costs incurred by the mass event organizer. In order to completely fulfill the requirements of the legislative act it is necessary to mount in line with the projects from 600 to even 900 cameras, as it is the case of the National Stadium.

Those cameras need to fulfill the special requirements as:

1. The object 50 cm has to give photo with 1000 pixels.
2. No less than 12 frame per second
3. Shutter – 1/125



Mr. Dziewulski is interested in offers from companies who are able to install those cameras and are able to help him reduce the amount of cameras in stadiums while staying within the boundaries of the new ACT. Mr. Dziewulski can introduce the offer directly to contractor of national stadium and other stadiums.
