PL.2012

PL.2012 is the coordinator and overseer of the preparation undertakings for Euro 2012 in Poland. The enterprise has called together national coordinators and given them particular areas of oversight and operations. A 46-member team of experts and qualified managers has been assembled. PL.2012 is working closely with the Ministry of Sport and Tourism, UEFA, the Polish FA and representatives of Ukraine. It is coordinating the work of host city organizational bodies.

Oversight functions include, among others:

- analysis of legal regulations which may affect the preparation and realization of undertakings connected with EURO 2012;
- periodic assessment of the state of preparations, monitoring of undertakings, and definition of threats to the realization of preparations for EURO 2012.

Medical care

In less than one and a half year before the tournament, the full list of the so-called reference hospitals has been announced. This list concerns the institutions dedicated to medical cover in the 4 host cities of Euro 2012 in Poland.

The list includes hospitals representing medical facilities for stadiums, fan zones, the football teams, the (organizers of) UEFA and other guests. The main criterion for creating a list of health care centers was their location in regard to the official tournament: i.e. the stadiums, fan zones, the 'UEFA Family accommodations' and the training camps.

An overview

The reference hospitals for the stadiums:

- the National Stadium in Warsaw: Bródnowski Hospital
- Poznan: the HCP Medical Centre Sp. z oo



- Wrocław: the District Hospital
- Gdańsk: the Hospital of St. Wojciech Adalbert

Reference hospitals for the fan zones (i.e. the public viewing of the matches, held in conjunction with UEFA in the host cities):

- Warsaw: the Czerniakowski Hospital and the Wolski Hospital
- Poznań: the Jeżyce Hospital, the multidisciplinary Municipal Hospital. J. Ostrich and the 111 Military Hospital
- Gdańsk: the University Centre for Clinical and Traumatology, the Pomeranian Centre and the Provincial Specialist Hospital 'Copernicus'
- Wrocław: the University Clinical Hospital

Reference list of hospitals, which will provide medical care for the football teams and the UEFA Family:

- Warsaw: the Central Clinical Hospital Ministry of Internal Affairs and the Military Institute of Medicine
- Gdańsk: Central Clinical Hospital Ministry of Defense and the Ministry of Internal Affairs Hospital
- Poznań: the Hospital MIA them. Prof. L. Bierkowskiego
- Wrocław: the 4th Military Clinical Hospital with Polyclinic

The reference hospitals will form the backbone of the health care during Euro 2012. Nevertheless they will only help these patients requiring diagnosis or treatment in an hospital. During Euro 2012 the basic medical assistance will be provided directly to fans and tourists in the stadiums and fan zones. Special first-aid locations will be set up and in addition, on-site doctors, emergency medical teams and paramedics' foot patrols will be working in and around the stadium and fan zones. Fans and tourists will also be able to use primary care in specially selected health clinics. These institutions will be designated as 'European offices'.

Tenders

Q: Will there be any open tenders and if there will be in which field and at what time span?

A: On current advanced level of Polish preparations to Euro 2012 the majority of tenders is published and finalized. Additionally, PL.2012 didn't organize any tender connected with preparations and investments/activities.

PL.2012 is a public company which is responsible for coordinating and controlling the process of preparations in whole country. We are cooperating with more than 170 public entities responsible for realizing investments and activities in terms of Euro 2012, but we are not realizing any investments.



Q: Is there in a certain area advice or help needed from foreign countries such as The Netherlands?

A: We cooperate with several countries, which organized big sports events like UEFA EURO and we are using the best practices from other countries and exchanging our knowledge and experiences in that matter.
