#### **PL.2012**

PL.2012 is the coordinator and overseer of the preparation undertakings for Euro 2012 in Poland. The enterprise has called together national coordinators and given them particular areas of oversight and operations. A 46-member team of experts and qualified managers has been assembled. PL.2012 is working closely with the Ministry of Sport and Tourism, UEFA, the Polish FA and representatives of Ukraine. It is coordinating the work of host city organizational bodies.

Oversight functions include, among others:

- analysis of legal regulations which may affect the preparation and realization of undertakings connected with EURO 2012;
- periodic assessment of the state of preparations, monitoring of undertakings, and definition of threats to the realization of preparations for EURO 2012.

#### **Accommodation during Euro 2012**

During Euro 2012 one million fans / tourists are expected to come to Poland.

In the following accommodations they are expected to find a place to stay overnight:

- Hotels
- Motels
- Guesthouses
- Private accommodation
- Campsites (Using tents on large fields is considered as an realistic and cheap solution.
- Student dormitories



According to the guidelines of UEFA accommodations for fans should be in the tournament's host cities, or a maximum of just two hour drive from the stadium.

The main cities and villages where fans can be hosted are:

- Warsaw
- Lodz
- Wroclaw
- Krakow
- Katowice
- Poznań
- Bydgoszcz
- Torun
- Gdansk
  
- Kolobrzeg
- Ustka
- Kazimierz Dolny
- Naleczow
- Ostrody

The numbers of places to sleep for the fans are estimated at approximately:

*(these figures include accommodation in different standards of quality and price)*

Warsaw	101.000 beds
Gdansk	198.000
Poznan	64.000
Wroclaw	61.000

➔ Host cities themselves are responsible for the accommodations.



Concerning the organization of accommodation for Euro 2012, PL2012 is already cooperating with booking.com, an hotel reservation service of Dutch origin. The contact person in Poland is Frank Staiger. In December more information will be available concerning the necessities to accommodate all the fans and other Euro 2012 related people, because then the playing scheme will be published. The only thing know right now, is that de half final and finals will be played in the National stadium in Warsaw.
