Eunite Ukraine (EU): When was Ternopil Stadium constructed?

Mr. Yaroslav Kolesnikov (YK): The first historical reference on Ternopil City Stadium dates back to August, 21, 1909. The stadium underwent several reconstructions, the largest of which was held in 1983-1984, after which the stadium got a look of a closed bowl. In 90-ties the Western Stand of the Stadium was thoroughly repaired – a new roof cover and plastic seats for spectators (around 3500 pieces) were installed there.

Current reconstruction of the Stadium has been launched in 2009.

EU: What is the current state of Ternopil Stadium infrastructure development?

YK: Premises underneath stands (where changing rooms, sanitary conveniences, shower rooms and other utility rooms are located) have been repaired; modern heating, water supply and ventilation systems have been installed. Our pitch is equipped with modern automated irrigation and heating systems.

Roof cover over the Stadium South Stand has been recently installed. Assembling of a roof cover over the Stadium East Stand is currently underway.

EU: What are the main objectives and future deliverables of Ternopil Stadium reconstruction project?

YK: Our reconstruction project covers installation of a roof cover along the whole perimeter of the Stadium stands; replacing of old wooden seats to new plastic ones; external finishing of the stadium; development of territory around the Stadium; installation of artificial lighting system (intensity 1200 lux); reconstruction of running tracks; replacement of natural grass; as well as installation of modern display board.

It is also planned to develop an additional sport ground of 60x40m.

Project design of a new hotel, underground parking, commercial and catering facilities construction has been developed for premises underneath the North and South Stadium Stands.

EU: What will be Ternopil Stadium seating capacity after the reconstruction?

YK: According to our preliminary calculations it was planned to have 15,423 seats. But after conducting some examinations and taking into account fire safety norms, we made some corrections. According to these changes our Stadium has to be splitted into bigger quantity of sectors to provide additional passages between them.



Creation of additional vertical passages decreased the estimated number of stadium seats. Corresponding amendments have been implemented into project design.

After the reconstruction our Stadium will have 15 000 seats.

EU: What is the total budget of Ternopil Stadium reconstruction? What is the financial source of the project?

YK: Total budget for reconstruction of Ternopil City Stadium is 22 054 thousand UAH, excluding costs for a new hotel and parking construction. The Stadium reconstruction is being held on budget expense of Ternopil City Council, which owns the Stadium.

EU: When do you plan to finish the reconstruction of the Stadium?

YK: In case of due financing it is planned to complete the Stadium reconstruction in December 2011.

EU: Who is the general contractor of the project?

YK: Ternopil City Council signed an agreement with construction company "Dobrobud", which won the tender for stadium reconstruction.

EU: Did you already select suppliers of plastic seats and lighting systems?

YK: At the moment this is an open issue, as the final decision has not been taken yet. Suppliers will be determined through the tender.

Our budget for 1 plastic seat including its installation is 150 UAH.

Total budget for lighting system will be in-between 2,5 and 3 million UAH.
